Step 1: Student and Parent FSA ID:

- Create an FSA ID at <u>www.studentaid.gov</u> Click on "create an account"
- You will need personal and parent information: Full name, birthdate, address, email and social security number. Parent without a social security number WILL also create an FSA ID and will select "do not have a social security number".
